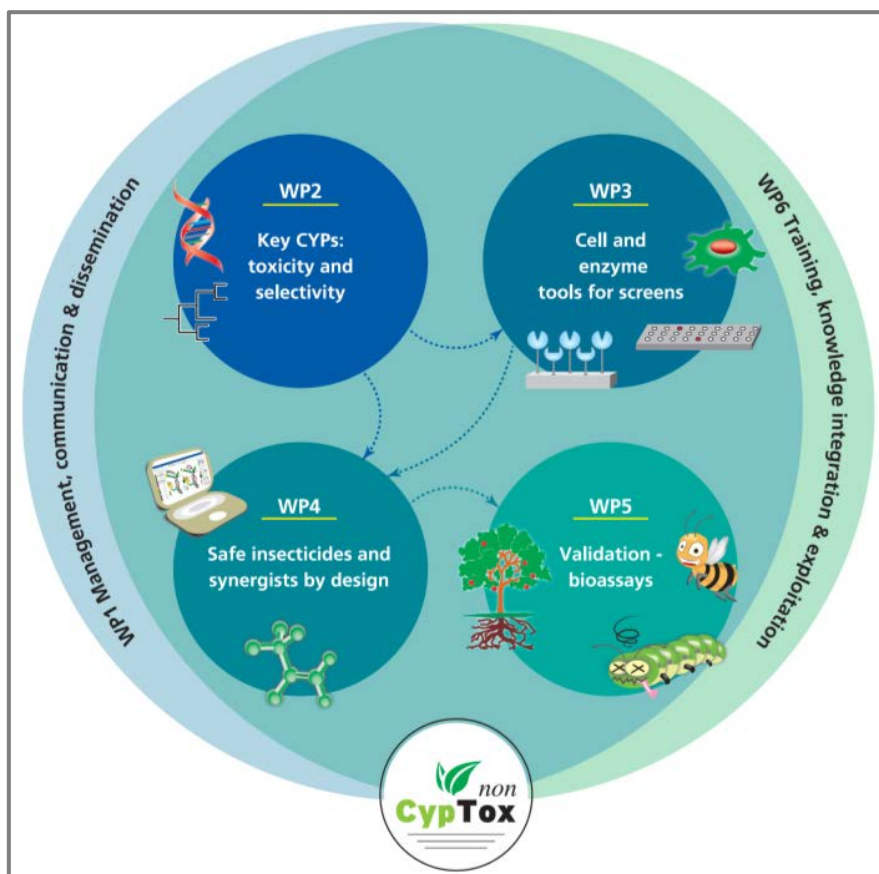

ZOOM TUTORIAL

To launch Zoom, either:

If you have already installed the Zoom application:

1. Open Zoom
2. Enter the Meeting ID and Password

If you would like to download and install Zoom on your machine now:

1. Click on the meeting link
2. Click "Download Now"
3. Then follow installation instructions

If you would like to join from your browser without installing Zoom:

1. Select a Zoom preferred browser such as Chrome, Firefox and Chromium Edge.
2. Click on "Join from Your Browser"
3. Then enter your name and complete the reCAPTCHA
4. Finally, agree to the Terms of Service

To "Join Audio", select your preferred input, (Computer Audio or a connected device)

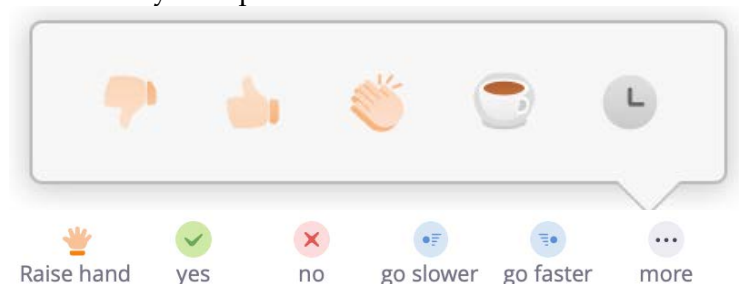
Note that we recommend remaining muted unless you will be speaking to increase meeting quality;

To "Start video", select your preferred input

Note that there is a common misperception that cutting your video feeds may increase meeting quality. Zoom corrects for this automatically and we recommend leaving your video on to improve interactions and thus overall meeting quality.

To "Raise your hand" or give other feedback:

1. Click on participants
2. Click on your option of choice below:



Note that you can also change your name by choosing the "Rename" button

To use the Chat function:

Click on the Chat icon to see the chat

2. Type your message
3. Send your message by pressing return
